# Report

OF

## THE PALI TEXT SOCIETY

FOR 1889.

---

THE Chairman of the Society has only this year to report that Professor Kuhn has given up his intention of editing the *Netti Pakarāṇa*, and Dr. Steinthal his intention of editing the *Mahā-vaṅsa*. On the other hand, Mr. Strong has undertaken the editing of *Budhi-vaṅsa*.

The editions of the great *Nikāyas* are going on in a satisfactory way. Vol. I. of the *Digha* is now issued to subscribers, and Vol. II. is in preparation. Vol. II. of the *Samyutta* has been published, and Vol. III. is passing through the press. Professor Windisch's edition of the *Iti-vuttaka* is nearly ready for issue; and an edition of the *Saddhamma Saṅgaha* is in the press, and will be issued to subscribers for the year 1890. As these three last-mentioned works are so nearly ready, subscribers may expect to receive their works for 1890 early in that year.
